

## How Can I Get Involved?

### CHRISTIAN FORMATION POINTS OF CONTACT

**TotalChaosInTheNameOfTheLordAmen!** (grades 5 and 6) — This high-energy group works to build community through fun fellowship activities, trips, and overnights.

**Sunday Evening Youth Group** (grades 7-12) — Every Sunday evening from 6 to 8 p.m., this group begins with dinner for everyone and then junior-high and senior-high groups gather for their own discussion and activities.

**Confirmation Classes** (grades 7 & 8, plus fall of 9th grade year) — St. Paul's offers a two-year program, in seventh and eighth grade, culminating in the bishop's visitation during the ninth grade year, as the first opportunity for confirmation.

**Sunday Morning Youth Forum** (grades 9-12) — High school students meet from 10-10:45 a.m. each Sunday to reflect on the meaning of God's word in their lives and to learn and discuss how to think theologically about the world.

**Youth Stewardship** — This group of teenagers meets monthly for discussion and planning as it seeks to raise funds and awareness of our blessings from God and responsibilities to the rest of creation.

**Drama Dreamers** — Our teenagers produce, direct, act, serve as tech and stage crew, and sometimes write for annual productions of Advent Dessert Theater and a spring musical.

**Acolytes** — High school-aged members of the parish are invited to provide liturgical leadership and assist the congregation in offering the 9 and 11am worship services.

**Children's and Youth Choirs** — Children's choirs rehearse on Thursday afternoons and the Youth Choir rehearses on Sunday mornings. Please see the *Guide to Programs* for full descriptions of each choir and singing schedule.

**Church School** — Classes are offered for every age from 10 to 10:45 a.m. each Sunday. Grades 1-4 meet in the South Wing; older classes on second and third floors.

**Sunday Morning Preschool Program** — Open to all 3-year-olds through kindergarten students. Coordinated by Amy Speidel with help from Carnella Peck, Fran Cohen and parent volunteers, this time together includes singing, story-time, prayers and lots of free play.

**Youth and Family Apostleship** — Our newest intern Clara Coughlin will help us offer new opportunities for children, youth and families to be engaged in hands-on outreach. Please contact Clara to find out more.

**Diocesan Youth Events** — The Episcopal Diocese of Ohio offers conference retreats for middle school and high school students in which St. Paul's actively participates.
